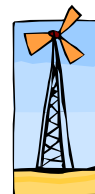

 - offer information and guidance on appropriate site and location for small wind systems
 - give a general cost estimate for small wind systems
 - determine the minimum acceptable tower height for a particular site
 - provide other assistance in making a small wind system a reality
